Tuition for the School Year 2015-2016 (Tentative)

Tuition is comprised of three separate fees including:

1. **Registration Fee-** \$100- Paid annually
2. **Tuition-** Varies depending on grade and number of children
 - a. Grades 8-12- \$5500 (No Sibling Discount)
 - b. Grades PK- 7- \$4800 (Sibling Discount Applies; please see chart)
3. **Affiliation fee-** Paid only for students with no siblings already registered at Al-Noor.
This is a ONE TIME fee paid for the first child in each family to register at Al-Noor.

Tuition Payment Schedule

1. First Installment is due by July 10, 2015 or at the time of registration.
2. Second Installment is due by November 10, 2015.
3. Third Installment is due by February 10, 2016.

Tuition Withdrawal/ Refund Policy

1. Registration fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE/ NON-TRANSFERABLE**.
2. 100% refund of tuition if registration is cancelled 1 Week before school starts
3. 90% refund of tuition during the 1st week of school.
4. 50% refund of tuition during the 2nd week of school.
5. 0% refund of tuition 1 Month into the school year.
